## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Court has received no information from law enforcement officials that would cause the Courts of the State of Florida not to work their normal and usual hours with regular procedures. Therefore, the courts of the State of Florida are to continue with normal and usual hours of operation with regular procedures, subject to chief judges of the district courts and of the circuit courts exercising discretion as to their courts based upon local circumstances. If a district or circuit chief judge makes a decision which changes normal and usual hours of operation, the chief judge is to advise this Court of that change.
